LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. <u>94-470</u>

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 94-469, the Tohono O'Odham

Legislative Council issued confidential instructions to

certain officials of the Nation with respect to certain

matters related to pending litigation; and

WHEREAS, disclosure of such instructions would be damaging to the interests of the Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Resolution No. <u>94-469</u> shall be sealed by the Legislative Secretary and maintained in a locked file.
- 2. The Chairman of the Legislative Council shall, upon request, make Resolution No. 94-469 available for inspection by the members of the Legislative Council, the Chairman of the Nation, the Attorney General and such other officials of the Nation whom, in the judgment of the Council Chairman, have a demonstrated and immediate need to review the Resolution which is compatible with the Nation's interests. In permitting any such inspection, the Chairman of the Legislative Council shall set such conditions advisable may be prevent unauthorized disclosure of the Resolution.
