RESOLUTION NO. 94-479

**WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council is asking the support of the
Tohono O'odham Legislative Council to transfer the
former Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) buildings located
in Santa Rosa to the District of Gu Achi; and**

**WHEREAS, on November 10, 1982, the Gu Achi District Council did
submit Resolution No. 08-83 with the inten that the
transfer of BIA buildings and related property would be
finalized; and**

**WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council desires to take the
responsibility of the building maintenance, renovation
and use, when the facilities are inspected and declared
safe.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council hereby supports the Gu Achi District
Council's request that the former Bureau of Indian
Affairs (BIA) buildings be transferred to the authority of
the Gu Achi District Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council on the 10TH. day of NOVEMBER, 1994 at a
meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,665.0 FOR;
-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 98.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to
the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(4) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
