- 1. Every effort possible has been made to actively develop and implement acceptable relief plans to ameliorate the negative impacts of FTE reductions and the elimination of temporary positions; and
- 2. Prior to any changes, the Tohono O'odham Nation must be consulted regarding FTE reductions, early buyouts and the elimination of temporary positions which may result in possible restructuring at the local Sells Service Unit.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the <u>10TH.</u> day of <u>NOVEMBER</u>, <u>1994</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,763.0</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>10</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section $\underline{1(c)(2)}$ of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
