RESOLUTION NO. 94-495

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation Social Service Department entered into an agreement between the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) on October 01, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation under Resolution 94-393 approved the consolidation structure combining the Health Department, Department of Social Services and the Needy Family Food Program into the "DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES" ; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services, Division of Senior Services agrees to provide In-Home Custodial Care Services for eligible clients, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services, Division of Senior Services was reimbursed according to the fee schedules and procedures of AHCCCS in the amount of \$22,764.00; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services, Division of Senior Services is proposing to use these funds for six months salary including fringe benefits for the manager position; and

18 **funding or funding levels of this contract shall be**
19 **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


