3 **WHEREAS, on December 01, 1994 the Nation was informed of a**
4 **Congressionally mandated streamlining reduction titled**
5 **FY 1995 Procurement Reform Savings; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the across-the-board general reduction of 0.191 percent**
8 **has been distributed to each area and agency; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the amount identified as "savings" to the Federal**
10 **Government for the Papago Agency is \$12,276, which for**
11 **the Nation means a reduction in funding; and**

13 **WHEREAS, on December 2, 1994 the Nation and the Papago Agency**
14 **met to discuss the reduction and distribution of this**
15 **reduction; and**

17 **WHEREAS, it was decided that the total reduction of \$12,276 would**
18 **be shared equally between the Papago Agency and the**
19 **Tohono O'odham Nation which means \$6,138 will be**
20 **applied to the Nation and \$6,138 to the Agency; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch of the Nation recommends Option**
22 **1 as reflected in the attached table to equitably**
23 **distribute the reduction to the 9 programs on the Tribal**
24 **Priority Allocation/TBS System.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to execute the adjustments with the Papago Agency/Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH. day of DECEMBER, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present, and by a vote of 276.0 FOR; 644.0 AGAINST; 613.0 NOT VOTING; and 230.0 [07] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
