WHEREAS, Indigenous peoples throughout the world, the United States, including the Tohono O'odham Nation have historically been and continue to be subject to legally invalid, immorally condemnable and socially unjust violations of their individual and collective human rights

WHEREAS, the United Nation's Working Group on the Rights of Indigenous Populations has, in 1993, completed a decade of preparatory work on the DRAFT Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples that will proclaim and strengthen the rights of American Indians, including the Tohono O'odham Nation, Alaskan Natives and all other

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the value of the United Nation's Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples due to its future impact on current issues relative to the Tohono O'odham Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby supports and promotes the United Nation's Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples by promoting its contents to local, state, national, and world officials concerning the plight

of Indigenous Peoples worldwide.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that it will appropriate adequate funding to send
Delegates to subsequent United Nations meeting in
Geneva Switzerland to speak on behalf of the Tohono
O'odham Nation. Such appropriation request will be
presented to the Legislative Council when deemed
appropriate.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the <u>9TH.</u> day of <u>DECEMBER</u>, <u>1994</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,763.0</u> FOR; <u>-0-AGAINST</u>; <u>-0-NOT VOTING</u>; and <u>05 ABSENT</u>, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section <u>1(d)</u>, (c)(2) & (8) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
