NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pisinemo District Council requests approval of the addition of \$60,000.00 to the Pisinemo District Budget to be used by the communities of Pisinemo, Santa Cruz, San Simon, and Kupk/Dirtburn in an equal installment of \$15.000.00 per community.
