(Approval of Pisinemo District Community Budgets)**

3 **WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Pisinemo District Council**  
4 **held on December 7, 1994, the Pisinemo District Council**  
5 **did approve the budgets of the communities of Pisinemo,**  
6 **Santa Cruz, San Simon, and Kupk/Dirtburn; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the addition of the total budgets in the amount of**  
8 **\$60,000.00 will be added to the Pisinemo District's FY-95**  
9 **Budget with each aforementioned community receiving**  
10 **an equal amount of \$15,000.00 each; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the addition of such monies was stated in Resolution No.**  
13 **94-20 of the Pisinemo District Council presented and**  
14 **approved by the Pisinemo District Council on October**  
15 **12, 1994; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the approved Pisinemo District Budget was presented**  
18 **before the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council**  
19 **and approved by Resolution No. 94-441 of the Tohono**  
20 **O'odham Legislative Council on October 14, 1994.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pisinemo District**  
23 **Council requests approval of the addition of \$60,000.00**  
24 **to the Pisinemo District Budget to be used by the**  
25 **communities of Pisinemo, Santa Cruz, San Simon, and**  
26 **Kupk/Dirtburn in an equal installment of \$15,000.00 per**  
27 **community.**

3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the communities of Pisinemo, Santa  
4 Cruz, San Simon, and Kupk/Dirtburn each submitted  
5 their budget justifications before the Pisinemo District  
6 Council for approval at a regular meeting of the  
7 Pisinemo District Council held on December 7, 1994.

9 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
10 Council will approve the submission of Resolution No.  
11 94-28 from the Pisinemo District Council requesting an  
12 additional \$60,000.00 to be added to the Pisinemo  
13 District's FY-95 Budget to be used by the communities of  
14 Pisinemo, Santa Cruz, San Simon, and Kupk/Dirtburn  
15 with an equal distribution of \$15,000.00 per community.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham  
18 Legislative Council on the 9TH day of DECEMBER, 1994 at a meeting  
19 at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,533.0 FOR; -0-  
20 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 230.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the  
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the  
22 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
23 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
24 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
25 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
