**WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services is currently operating  
the Seriously Mentally Ill Day Treatment Program under  
a grant with the Indian Health Service/Department of  
Health & Human Services; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is currently providing  
mental health services through the Tohono O'Odham  
Human Service Department's Tohono O'Odham  
Psychological Services (TOPS) program through a P. L.  
93-638 grant; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Human Services Department  
recognizes the continued need for increased mental  
health services for the seriously and persistently  
mentally ill, particularly in the area of psychosocial  
rehabilitation; and**

**WHEREAS, Day Treatment Programs for the seriously and  
persistently mentally ill have been an effective means of  
providing psychosocial rehabilitation services; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Human Services Department, TOPS  
program and the Tucson Area Indian Health Service  
Mental Health Office have examined a Native American  
Day Treatment Program and found such a program to be**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative oversight committee did discuss and determined that it is in the best interest of the Nation to apply for funding for this Tribal Demonstration Project.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the scope and budget and authorizes the five year grant award from the Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Service, Indian Health Service, ISH001378 (Day Treatment Program for the Seriously Mentally Ill).**


