

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Appropriation for Operation, Maintenance
and Repair of Street Lighting of Highway 86 in Sells)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-534

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation ("ADOT") has secured federal funding to install street lights along Highway 86 in Sells between mile post 113 and mile post 115; and

WHEREAS, ADOT's October 1993 traffic engineering evaluation indicates that street lighting of this portion of the highway will contribute to the safety of Sells Community members as well as all those who use the highway; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ADOT'S proposal, ADOT will install the light poles, however, the Nation will be responsible for the cost of operation, maintenance and repair of the lights and poles; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee have suggested to the Nation's Utility Authority ("TOUA") that ADOT and TOUA enter into an agreement for the installation and operation of the street lights, and that TOUA bill the Nation accordingly for the annual cost of operation, maintenance and repair; and

WHEREAS, TOUA estimates the annual cost of operation, maintenance and repair between \$5,000 and \$19,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Tohono O'Odham Utility Authority is authorized to collect from the Nation the annual cost of the operation, maintenance and repair of the street lights ADOT proposes to install in Sells on Highway 86.**
- 2. The sum of \$19,000., is hereby appropriated from the Nation's General Fund to cover the annual cost of such operation, maintenance and repair.**
- 3. Tohono O'Odham Utility Authority shall submit to the Nation's Chief Financial Officer a written proposal and budget for the annual cost of such operation, maintenance and repair.**
- 4. The Chief Financial Officer shall add such cost to the appropriate tribal budget and amend such budget for the current fiscal year accordingly; hereafter, the Chief Financial Officer shall include such annual cost in the appropriate annual budget.**
- 5. Any amount of this appropriation not utilized in this current fiscal year for the cost of operation,**


