

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Resolution No. 94-516 to identify Funding Sources  
for Christmas Bonus Payments)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-546**

**WHEREAS, Resolution No. 94-516 provides that the total amount of \$728,696.00 for Christmas Bonus payments be appropriated from the Nation's Special Reserve Account, as indicated:**

**WHEREAS, a clarification is needed in that Resolution No. 94-516 did not identify the funding source for Desert Diamond Casino employees and officials to be provided for from the Operating Expense Account of the Gaming Operation, consistent with last year's funding source; and**

**WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has advised the Budget & Finance Committee that the current balance of \$316,703.76 in the Special Reserve account less the appropriations for Christmas Bonus payments, excluding the portion for Desert Diamond Casino, will result in a shortfall of \$66,092.24, as follows:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Legislative Council that it hereby amends Resolution No. 94-516 to identify the Operating Expense Account of the Gaming Operation as the source of funding for Christmas Bonus payments for Desert Diamond Casino employees and officials.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Legislative Council that it further identifies the General Revenue Account as the source of funding to cover the \$66,092.24 shortfall for Christmas Bonus payments.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. day of DECEMBER, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,070.0 FOR; 542.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 151.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
