4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation has provided preventive health care
5 for women, infants and children on reservation during Fiscal Year

9 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of
10 Agreement with Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona (ITCA) to fund and
11 operate the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Traditional Indian Alliance of Greater Tucson, Inc. (TIA), is a
14 community based, non-profit organization. TIA currently provides
15 health and social services to off-reservation Tohono O'odham and
16 other Native Americans; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona has requested the closest,
20 existing ITCA WIC program to work with TIA to develop a service
21 delivery method and a plan of action for the provision of WIC
22 services to those urban Native American women, infants and

27 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation WIC Program is negotiating with the
28 TIA director and board that a six month demonstration project


