4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Social Service has the primary responsibility
5 to provide for the care, treatment and welfare of O'Odham families
6 found to be in need of such care; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Title IV-B Subpart 2 of the Social Security Act provides funds for
9 development of a Five Year Plan for demonstrating effective
10 prevention approaches for handling increasing family problems
11 under specified terms and conditions; and

14 **WHEREAS,** a proposal has been submitted for review and approval by the
15 Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department for the FY-1994 Family
16 Preservation/Family Support Services Program.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
20 Council that it does hereby approve the application of the Tohono
21 O'Odham Social Service to the Department of Health & Human
22 Services/Administration for Children and Families to develop the

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the
28 Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in

5 executed grant has been approved by the Department of Health &

8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the

10 Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman and any

12 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute

14 the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
15
16 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for
17
18 further prior approval by this Council.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
20 on the 12TH day of JANUARY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was
21 present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02
22 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article
23 VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
