**WHEREAS, the 1994 Fiscal Year ended at midnight, September 30, 1994, and all
spending authority granted under 1994 budgets ended at that time;**

and

**WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Law Enforcement Department of the
Tohono O'Odham Nation was granted spending authority at the FY
94 level by the Legislative Council under a continuing resolution;**

and

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has requested review of the final remaining
dollar amount expended from the Special Appropriations during FY
94 before approving the FY 95 budget; and**

**WHEREAS, the Executive Administration has provided from its' Accounting
Department a detailed report on the expenditures of the Law
Enforcement Department for FY 94; and**

**WHEREAS, the Executive Branch of the Nation has prepared and presented a
budget that reflects the needs of the Law Enforcement Department;
and**

WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees, and the
Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation has reviewed this
budget and recommends its approval and adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono
O'Odham Nation that it approves the FY 95 Carry-Over Budget of
the Law Enforcement Department in the amount of \$1,607,627.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that quarterly reports on said budget be submitted
to Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
on the 13TH day of JANUARY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was
present with a vote of 1,372.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 391.0
[09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of
Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
