

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**

**(Approving expenditures of funds in relation to money made available  
through the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development,  
Office of Native American Programs, Imminent Threat  
Fund for emergency relief due to natural disaster)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-030**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation, through its Planning and Operations  
Department, did apply for and receive \$186,000.00 for emergency  
roof repairs for homes damaged in the August 12, 1994 storm that  
affected seven districts of the Nation (those being: Hickiwan,  
Pisinemo, Gu Vo, Gu Achi, Baboquivari, Schuk Toak and Sif Oidak).**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Treasury Department,  
Grants and Contracts, is authorized to establish an account for  
expenditures on the approved projects and disperse federal monies  
as invoices are submitted and labor is performed following all of  
the Nation's procedures.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that expenditures related to roof repairs may be  
made from the Nation's General Fund account pending  
reimbursement by HUD's Imminent Threat monies, the total not to  
exceed \$186,000.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 13TH day of JANUARY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,485.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 135.0 NOT VOTING; and 278.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




