

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(\$5,000 Grant Request to the Tohono O'odham Nation to aid the O'odham
Language Enhancement Project)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-033

WHEREAS, the traditional language of the Tohono O'odham is a vital part of
today's education for our people. Speaking the O'odham language
will lead to better understanding and maintaining our culture.

WHEREAS, the University of Arizona/Pima Community College Southwestern
Language Articulation Task Force group, will be seeking funding
through grants to enhance the language courses at both institutions;
and

WHEREAS, the grant monies when acquired, will be used to develop teaching
curriculum, language tapes, textbooks, and teaching methods for the
language faculty; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of grant monies have certain maximum dollar limits,
other additional funding will be needed to aid the project towards
a reasonable time of completion. The University of Arizona/Pima
Community College Southwestern Language Articulation Task Force
group is requesting from the Tohono O'odham Nation, a grant in
the amount of \$5,000 to assist in the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation, that it

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
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agrees to the granting of \$5,000 to the language project of the University of Arizona/Pima Community College Southwestern Language task Force group, for the purpose of language enhancement.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 13TH day of January, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,334.0 FOR; 89.0 AGAINST; 62.0 NOT VOTING; and 278.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


