

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY '96 Appropriations Priority Listing)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-056**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council establishes priorities annually for consideration by Congress during its Appropriations Hearings; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee has solicited input from the Nation's Districts in establishing top priorities based on the needs and type of services provided to the people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee, upon review of district responses have established the following (10) areas as the top priorities for FY 1996 for consideration by Congress during its Appropriations Hearings.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby adopts the following appropriations priority ranking for FY 1996 and respectfully urges Congress to appropriate such funds as necessary to increase the ten (10) areas to an exemplary level of funding, with ranking as follows:**

- 1. Education**
- 2. Roads**
- 3. Health**
