

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Support and Intent to engage in Partnership with Pima Community

College in the operation of the

Upward Bound Program [CFDA 84.087A])

RESOLUTION NO. 95-060

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5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation is empowered
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7 to secure the health, welfare and education of the membership of the
8
9 nation and considers educational advancement of tribal members as
10 among the highest of priorities; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the high secondary school attrition rate and low post secondary
12
13 enrollment rates of tribal members are matters of the greatest concern
14
15 and must be addressed if the Tohono O'odham Nation is to meet its
16 goals of self-determination economic independence; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation intends to actively participate in the

19 proposed partnership with Pima Community College and other Tribal
20
21 entities for the purpose of applying for and conducting an Upward
22
23 Bound Program that will serve Tohono O'odham high school students
24 and other American Indian participants.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative

27 Council herein endorses the joint application submitted through the
28 East Campus of Pima County Community College to the Upward Bound
Program (CFDA 84.047A) as provided by U.S.C. 1221e-(a)(1).

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham
Nation, is authorized to sign a proposal pre-agreement and to
subsequently negotiate and enter into any sub-agreements or
intergovernmental agreements with Pima Community College, subject
upon approval of the Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on
the 9TH day of FEBRUARY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT,
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary
- Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
