Modification #1, Calendar Year FY95 Planning Allocation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95-067

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the JTPA Title II-B ACP/Program under FY 1995 Contract with the State of Arizona Department of Economic Security; and

WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted to reflect and increase in the appropriation for the JTPA Title II-B Summer Youth Employment Training Program of \$17,996.00 to reflect calendar year 1995 Planning Allocation in the total amount of \$17,996.00; and

WHEREAS, Title II-B Summer Youth employment will also show a decrease in the Indirect Cost from 30.7% to 15.5% in the amount of \$1,026.00.

ACP - \$ 2,920.00

Program - \$16,102.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment to the JTPA Title II-B ACP/Program and authorizes expenditure in accordance with the attached budget.
