RESOLUTION NO. 95-078

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation has the authority to approve a District's expenditure of I.I.M. funds; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Constitution (1986) Article IX, Section 5, delegates to Districts within the Nation the authority and responsibilities to govern themselves in all matters of local concern; and

WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has the responsibility and authority to protect the public welfare, safety, health and morals of District members; and

WHEREAS, the San Lucy District purchased a Handicapped Van to transport District members who require "special" handicapped assistance; and

WHEREAS, said Van has provided outstanding service to the District's Health and Human Services Department; and

WHEREAS, continued repairs on said Van are no longer cost efficient and the Health and Human Services Department recommends purchasing a new Handicapped Van; and

WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council reviewed the need for the new

Resolution No. 01-01-95 authorizing the expenditure of \$27,000.00
to purchase said van and further that this amount be charged to
the District I.I.M. account.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby
approves the expenditure of San Lucy District's I.I.M. funds, in the
amount of \$27,000.00 to purchase a new handicapped van.**




