

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Setting Date for Removal Hearing)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 95-080

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4 **WHEREAS, Mr. Alex Ramon, Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
5 **Council, filed an Accusation for Removal ("Accusation") against Mr.**
6 **Chester Antone, Pisinemo District Representative, with the Judiciary**
7 **Committee in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article**
8 **IX of the Uniform Election Ordinance, alleging gross neglect of duty**
9 **under Section 4.A. of Article II of the Legislative Rules of the**
10 **Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and**

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14 **WHEREAS, on February 21, 1995 the Judiciary Committee held a hearing and**
15 **received evidence on the Accusation against Chester Antone, and by**
16 **Resolution No. JUD-01-95 determined that there is reasonable cause**
17 **to believe that the accused has committed a removal offense as**
18 **charged in the Accusation; and**

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22 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee filed the Resolution and the Accusation**
23 **with the Secretary of the Legislative Council in accordance with the**
24 **provisions of Section 2.D. of Article IX of the Uniform Election**
25 **Ordinance; and**

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28 **WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Legislative Council to set a hearing on the**

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3 **Accusation. The Uniform Election Code provides for the Legislative**
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5 **Council to set a hearing on the Accusation.**

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED THAT:**
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- 8 1. A hearing on the Accusation against Mr. Chester Antone,

10 Legislative Representative from Pisinemo District, will be held
11 on Tuesday, March 28, 1995, at 9:00 a.m., in the Council
12 Chambers of the Legislative Council in Sells, Arizona.
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14 2. The Secretary of the Legislative Council shall provide copies of
15 (a) the Accusation against Mr. Chester Antone, (b) the Resolution
16 of the Judiciary Committee No. JUD-01-95, (c) the Rules of
17 Procedure for Removal Hearings, and (d) notice of the date and
18 time for the removal hearing, to Mr. Chester Antone and Mr.
19 Alex Ramon forthwith and not less than ten days before the
20 date set for the hearing.
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25 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on
26 the 6TH. day of MARCH, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
27 with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT,
28 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(1) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham

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Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
