**RESOLUTION NO. 95-085**

**WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services now provides educational opportunities, counseling and financial assistance to eligible members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, a major Tohono O'odham Nation priority is to provide quality academic education to increase the number of Tohono O'odham professionals; and**

**WHEREAS, the number of applications has steadily increased while the staff of one Coordinator/Counselor under the Higher Education Services budget has remained the same.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby urgently request that Congress increase its appropriations for the Higher Education Services for the Tohono O'odham Nation and that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate members and committees of Congress.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 06TH, day of March, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 07**


