WHEREAS, the findings of the inventory clearly supports the Nation's claims of a severe and devastating condition of unmet housing needs within the Nation. Of the 2690 units existing, 1540 were classified substandard, 875 require total replacement, 877 needing housing and 665 needed rehab; and

WHEREAS, these conditions reflect the collective condition of Indian Housing across Indian Country as indicated in recent surveys conducted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs in which it was revealed that 98,781 new or substantially rehabilitated houses were needed in 1989 in order to meet minimum federal housing standards; and

WHEREAS, the movement to eliminate any Indian Housing Program or curtail
