

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(1996 Appropriations Request to Congress-Anti Crime Bill of 1993)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95-088

**WHEREAS, seventy five miles of the southern boundary of Tohono O'odham
Nation borders on the United States/Mexican International
Boundary; and**

**WHEREAS, there has been continuous problems of cattle rustling drug
trafficking and illegal entry of foreign nationals into the United
States; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Police Force is extremely limited in
manpower and funds to cover the vast area within its boundaries
including the International United States/Mexican Boundary.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council does hereby request that Congress appropriate \$1,065,834.00
in accordance with the attached Ranger Proposal.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby authorized
and directed to bring this request to the appropriate members and
committees of Congress.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 6TH day of MARCH, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,701.0 FOR; 62.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 07 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


