

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1996 Appropriation Request for Tohono O'odham Social Service
Program Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95-096

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Child Protective Services, Department of Human Services, Family Preservation, and Readiness Employment Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, such Social Service operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has the primary responsibility to provide for the care, treatment and welfare of children, families and financially dependent adults; and

WHEREAS, the incidence of child abuse and neglect in the Tohono O'odham Nation is high and increasing and family intervention and prevention services are limited and the lack of training and education continues to limit employment opportunities for financially dependent adults found to be in need; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has developed and administered a home based, intensive family service program which focuses on child protection, preventing family breakups and

the reunification of families, as well as a program that assists adults through education and training for job placements; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Human Services is eligible to apply for special Congressional Appropriations for departmental activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is in support of the request of the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services as herein stated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Tohono O'odham Appropriations Committee to submit this request in the amount of \$1,352,691.00 to the appropriate members and committees of Congress.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 07TH, day of March, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,492.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 271.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) and Article XVI Section 9 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






