4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation through Legislative Council Resolution  
5 No. 94-527, adopted on December 13, 1994 did express its support  
6 for peace for the Mayan peoples of Chiapas; and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation is seriously concerned of the  
9 developments in Mexico, as many O'odham do reside in Sonora  
10 Mexico, and may be affected by the outcome of the crisis in  
11 Chiapas; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Tucson based Chiapas coalition, "Pueblo Por La Paz" has  
15 extended to the Tohono O'odham Nation an invitation for two  
16 members to be a part of the peace delegation that will travel to  
17 Chiapas and meet with the leaders and elders of Chiapas; and

20 **WHEREAS,** it is in the interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue to  
21 express its support spiritually, politically, and financially to bring  
22 about peace for those less fortunate; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the value and rights of  
26 Indigenous people, such as the Mayan and O'odham because of

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby supports the efforts of the "Pueblo Por La Paz" Coalition of promoting peace by sending a peace delegation that includes members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'Odham Nation shall make a monetary donation of \$1,000., for food, medicine and other humanitarian aid from the General Revenue Account.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the \$3,000., appropriation made in Resolution No. 94-527 be re-obligated to this resolution to send two Representatives from the Tohono O'Odham Nation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 8TH day of MARCH, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 885.5 FOR; 565.5 AGAINST; 312.0 NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2), (c)(2) & (8) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




