

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

**(FY 1995 Community Health Services-Budget Modification No. 1
to De-obligate FY 1992-93 Funds and obligate funds in
the FY 1995 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95-108

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Department
of Human Services, Division of Community Health
Services/Community Counseling Relations Services under an FY 1995
P. L. 93-638 contract with Public Health Service, Indian Health
Services; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the
contract shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono
O'Odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation did submit its Financial Reports for the Community
Health Services/Community Counseling Relations Services to Indian
Health Service and did identify balances to be carried forward into
the FY 1995 contract; and**

**WHEREAS, due to the expiration of the Fiscal Year 1994 contract and
insufficient time to expend the funds identified, the Nation requests
to de-obligate FY 1994 funds in the amount of \$121,226.00 from
Community Health Services/Community Counseling Relations Services**

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Contract No. 249-94-0002 and obligate these funds in the FY 1995

Contract No. 249-95-0002; and

WHEREAS, the Community Health Service/Community Counseling Relations

Services has prepared and submitted its budget modification to

De-obligate FY 1994 funds and obligate funds in the FY 1995

budget; and

WHEREAS, the budget modification reflects the unexpended carryover monies

to be utilized within a 2 year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative

Council that it does hereby approve the amendment to the

Community Health Service/Community Counseling Relation Services

budget and requests the Indian Health Service to incorporate the

said budget into the Community Health Service Contract No.

249-95-0002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the

Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any

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designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
on the 9TH. day of MARCH, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
with a vote of 1,511.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 252.0[10]
ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article
VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


