**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the Tohono
O'Odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always reviewed the health care of the
children of the Nation as a priority of the Tribe; and**

**WHEREAS, the early onset of Type II Diabetes represents a major health
concern of the Nation for its children; and**

**WHEREAS, the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute of the National
Institutes of Health has included the Nation in a cooperative
program to examine ways to prevent obesity, a major risk factor
for Type II Diabetes in Native American children; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is willing to cooperate with Gila River Indian
Community and the University of Arizona in the exploration of
appropriate measures for obesity prevention; and**

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has been notified that funds will be

made available for FY 1995 of \$62,400., to accomplish the purposes
described above by the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute
through the Gila River Indian Community; and

WHEREAS, due to the expiration of the Fiscal Year 1994 Contract and
insufficient time to expend the funds identified, the Nation requests
to de-obligate these funds in the amount of \$12,589.00 (Direct Cost)
and \$1,951., (Indirect Cost) which reflect the reduction from 30.7%
to 15.5% and obligate these funds in the FY 1995 Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Health Department has prepared and
submitted its budget modification to de-obligate the amount for
review and approval to obligate into the FY 1995 budget for the
Obesity Prevention Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council hereby approves the FY 1995 budget and authorizes

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract proposal, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 9TH. day of MARCH, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,511.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 252.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
