

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Citizen Participation Certification for expending the balance of funds
from the Indian Community Development Block Grant, 1989)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-115

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, due to cost underruns in the 1989
Indian Community Development Block Grant program has an
unspent balance of \$27,226.71; and

WHEREAS, the need for housing renovation is acute throughout the Tohono
O'odham Nation;

WHEREAS, prior to the submission of an amendment request to expend funds
on home rehabilitation for the family of Mandro Jose, Anegam, Sif-
Oidak District, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided tribal
citizens, especially those living in areas where activities are
proposed or ongoing, with adequate information concerning the
amount of funds available for proposed community development
and housing activities, the range of activities that may be assisted
and other important program requirements, and solicited their
views and participation; and

WHEREAS, the traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement were followed
through notification to District Councils and Tohono O'odham

Legislative Council meetings, and opportunity was given to articulate needs, express preferences about proposed community development and housing activities, assist in the selection of District priorities, and otherwise participate in the development of the application; and

WHEREAS, comments or views expressed by Tribal members were considered and modified the application accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the modified application has been made available to Tribal members for review and comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby certifies that the Tohono O'odham Nation provided its citizens with the opportunity to participate in the development of the proposed Indian Community Development Block Grant amended request to spend the balance of \$27,226.71 from the 1989 ICDBG award.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10TH, day of March, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,255.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [508.0] 12 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) and
