

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriation of funds to Purchase Vehicles for Grant Programs)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-116

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation is authorized by the Tohono O'odham Constitution Article VI, Section 1(d) 2 to appropriate and authorize the expenditure of funds; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Operations Department through their analysis and in consultation with the Grants & Contracts Department and the Budget & Finance Committee, have determined that by purchasing vehicles in lieu of leasing the Nation would save a substantial amount of money; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Operations Department has developed the following plan:

- Vehicles will be purchased outright with Tribal funds**
- The Nation would be the owner of the vehicles and lease the vehicles to the Planning & Operations Department. These vehicles will be used in the administration of their grant programs.**
- The Tribal funds shall be reimbursed through the budgeted vehicle lease line items of grants.**

- These reimbursements shall be made to the Nation in the form of a lease agreement that requires full lease payment at the beginning of the lease term. This type of lease has been approved by HUD.

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation passed Resolution No. 94-436, approving the FY 1995 Executive Budget which contained a line item for Capital Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Equipment line item still has sufficient remaining funds to purchase vehicles as described above; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the use of the Capital Equipment line item for the purchase of these vehicles; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Capital Equipment line item shall be reimbursed from Grant funds after the vehicles are purchased and a lease agreement is finalized.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10TH, day of March, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,255.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [508.0] 12 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) 2 and


