4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation has learned the United States Senate
5 House Appropriations Subcommittee approved a bill which
6 eliminates or reduces funds for programs under the Labor
7 Department Job Training Partnership Act specifically the 1995 and
8 1996 Title II-B Summer Youth Employment Training Program and
9 the Program Year 1995 Title IV-A Section 401 Program and Tribal
10 JOBS Program; and

14 **WHEREAS,** this action defeats the purpose of the "Act" which is to establish
15 programs to prepare and provide youth and adults with job training
16 and other services that results in increased employment and
17 earnings, increased educational and occupation skills and decrease
18 welfare dependency, thereby improving the quality of the work
19 force and enhancing the productivity of the Tohono O'odham
20 Nation; and

25 **WHEREAS,** to eliminate or reduce funding critically denies a large number of
26 Tohono O'odham youth and adults the opportunity to fulfill their

11 **strongly opposes the termination and reduction in funding of the**
12 **JTPA Title II-B Summer Youth Program and the Tribal JOBS**

17 **Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation opposes the termination and**

pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
