(Decision on Appeal of Denial by San Lucy District Council of a Proposed
Adjustment in District Council's Schedule of Representatives)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-135

WHEREAS, Max Jose, a member of the Tohono O'odham Nation residing in San Lucy District, submitted a proposed resolution to the San Lucy District Council which requested an adjustment in the Schedule of Representatives to the District Council by increasing the number of representatives; and

WHEREAS, the proposed resolution was defeated by vote of the San Lucy District Council at a meeting held on February 9, 1995; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3(B) of the Uniform Election Ordinance Mr. Jose filed a timely appeal of the District Council's action; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 1995 the Legislative Council held a special meeting to hear the appeal; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council heard testimony and arguments presented by Mr. Jose, San Lucy District Chairperson Mary Hoffman, and members of the District.

Legislative Council hereby affirms the decision of the San Lucy
District Council to maintain the District's existing Schedule of
Representative and denies the appeal of Max Jose challenging the
rejection of the proposed adjustment of such schedule.

of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984); and Section 3(b) of Article
VI of the Uniform Election Ordinance of the Tohono O'odham Nation adopted
November 18, 1986..
