4 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal
5
6 Utility Authority, now known as Tohono O'Odham Utility Authority
7
8 (TOUA), for purposes of constructing, maintaining, and operating

10 various utility systems within the Nation to be owned wholly by the
11 Nation; and

12 **WHEREAS,** TOUA requests permission for a right-of-way for electric utilities
13
14 and a substation site (as described in the maps, legal description
15
16 and documents attached hereto and incorporated herein by
17
18 reference) within allotments 41, 194, 195 and Tribal Trust Land in

20 the San Xavier Community, San Xavier District, for uses consistent
with the authorized purposes of TOUA; and

21 **WHEREAS,** the San Xavier District Council has determined that the routing and

23 location of the right-of-way for electric utilities is not in conflict

25 with any land use plans adopted by the San Xavier District Council

27 and approved by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council and that

the right-of-way will be of substantial benefit to the San Xavier

District, the Tohono O'Odham Nation and their respective members;
and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council approved the requested right-of-way and substation site by its' District Council Resolution No.

SXDC 08-94-10; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the request for the right-of-way and substation site and recommends its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the right-of-way and substation site for the location (as more fully described in the attached maps and legal description) and construction by TOUA for uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 3RD day of APRIL, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,563.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 75.5 NOT VOTING; and 124.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(i) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


