4 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 94-450, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
5
6 approved an attorney contract with California Indian Legal Services
7
8 ("CILS"), to provide legal representation with respect to certain
9
10 cases arising in California under the Indian Child Welfare Act
11 ("ICWA"); and

12 **WHEREAS,** the attorney contract with CILS was effective as of October 1, 1994,
13
14 and continues in force until September 30, 1995; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the attorney contract with CILS was initially funded with an
16
17 allocation of \$5,000., which amount has been nearly expended
18
19 pursuant to the terms of the attorney contract; and

20 **WHEREAS,** CILS continues to provide legal representation to the Nation in
21
22 several cases arising under the ICWA and there is a recognized
23
24 need for the continuing legal services of CILS in such matters; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the approved budget for the Office of Attorney General for fiscal

27 year 1995 includes funding of \$10,000., for attorney contracts in

ICWA cases; one-half of which was appropriated under Resolution

No. 94-450 for the CILS attorney contract; and

**WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends that the Legislative
Council approve Amendment No. 1**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council approves Amendment
No. 1 to the attorney contract with CILS in the form attached
hereto.**
- 2. The Legislative Council authorizes the expenditure of the
additional sum of \$2,500., to pay the fees and expenses under the
attorney contract, as amended, and authorizes and directs
payment thereof from the budget of the Office of Attorney
General.**
- 3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute
amendment No. 1 to the attorney contract with CILS.**
