

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Budget Modification for Solid Waste Program)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-155

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4 **WHEREAS,** the Solid Waste Management Committee and the Environmental
5 Health Specialist of IHS-OEH&E developed a Solid Waste
6 Management Plan for the Tohono O'Odham Main Reservation; and
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8 **WHEREAS,** the Solid Waste Management Committee presented the Plan to the
9 Legislative Council; and
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11 **WHEREAS,** Tohono O'Odham Executive Staff has developed a draft Solid Waste
12 Ordinance for public review; and
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14 **WHEREAS,** the Solid Waste Management Plan has been presented to the
15 communities and the Districts in only a limited basis; and
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17 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Operations Department, in behalf of the Solid
18 Waste Management Committee, developed and submitted a Solid
19 Waste proposal to ITCA for further educational activities within the
20 districts; and
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24 **WHEREAS,** it has been recognized that, in addition to educational activities,
25 time and money must be allocated to reviewing, updating, and
26 researching implementation of the Solid Waste Plan and the Solid
27 Waste Ordinance; and
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3 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Proposal was funded by EPA through the Inter-**
4 **tribal Council of Arizona for FY 93 and FY 94; and**

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6 **WHEREAS, funds remaining in the FY 93 budget can be reallocated in the FY**
7 **94 budget which requires a budget modification; and**

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9 **WHEREAS, an agreement between the Nation and ITCA is required as well as**
10 **authorization to expend funds.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
13 **Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the**
14 **Chairman and any designated officials are hereby authorized to**
15 **negotiate and execute the grant agreement.**

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17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds identified in the attached budget of**
18 **the Solid Waste Proposal be approved for expenditures accordingly.**

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23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**
24 **on the 6TH day of APRIL, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present**
25 **with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 09 ABSENT,**
26 **pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the**
27 **Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
28 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


