

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 1996 Elderly Title VI
Program Grant Proposal)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-157

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the elderly members of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been possible in part by Article VI of the Older American's Act of 1986, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding by submitting a continuation proposal to the Office of Human Development Services, Administration on Aging for FY 1996 in the amount of \$71,007.; and

WHEREAS, the Elderly Program proposal will benefit elder members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation by providing for their nutritional and social support services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the proposal for continued funding of the Elderly Program to provide services to eligible members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence on April
01, 1995 and end on March 31, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the
Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
the grant provided however, that any amendments affecting the
funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
on the 6TH day of APRIL, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 10 ABSENT,
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
