RESOLUTION NO. 95-161

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has an interest in protecting and
preserving both the tangible and intangible attributes of its rich
cultural heritage; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has worked in concert with the Gila
River Indian Community, the Ak-Chin Indian Community, and the
Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community on matters affecting
cultural resources; and**

**WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community proposes to design, construct and
operate an archaeological repository for Central Arizona Project
artifacts and records, to be known as the Huhukam Heritage
Center.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports
the proposal of the Gila River Indian Community, as presented to
the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on April 3, 1995, for the
design, construction and operation of the huhukam Heritage Center.**
