4 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Housing and Urban Development guidelines
5
6 require a selection criteria for identifying those families most in
7
8 need of housing who will receive home renovations through the
9
10 **1995 HUD HOME grant program; and**

11 **WHEREAS,** the ten (10) Districts participating in the 1995 HOME grant program
12
13 (of the 11 Districts which comprise the Tohono O'Odham Nation)
14
15 defined their selection criteria on the basis of families with elderly,
16
17 handicapped members, families who live in seriously overcrowded
18
19 conditions, families living in a structurally unstable home, a home
20
21 in need of urgent repairs, a home with no amenities (i.e., indoor

23 plumbing, sewage lines), families with very low income not to
24
25 exceed 90% of the median income for the area adjusted for family

27 size; and

28 **WHEREAS,** District Councils consulted with their own Housing Committees and
reviewed the applicant list of the Tohono O'Odham Housing
Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Planning and Operations Department undertook a cost estimate for each of the proposed building renovations and that the estimate conformed to standards of the National Association of Real Estate Appraisers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the proposed selected participants and construction projects for the HUD Indian Home grant be therefore adopted for submission to HUD for funding.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 07TH, day of April, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,533.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 230.0 (10) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
