3 **WHEREAS,** the Executive Office and the Legislative Council approved resolution  
4  
5 #95-059 to provide funding for four (4) elder women from each  
6  
7 District to attend the Wellness & Women Conference; and

8 **WHEREAS,** a Wellness and Men Conference will be taking place in May, 1995  
9  
10 in Albuquerque, New Mexico; and

11 **WHEREAS,** there are other conferences and activities which specifically  
12  
13 addresses Elder concerns such as the White House Conference on  
14  
15 Aging in Washington, DC to be held in May and the Waila activity  
16  
17 happening in April, 1995, in Tucson, Arizona; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the line items for registration, travel and per diem for Senior  
19  
20 Services Division staff are not available due to budget restraints;  
21  
22 and

23 **WHEREAS,** it is recommended that all funding requests for elder concerns,  
24  
25 issues, staff training and travel be combined as one budget and  
26  
27 titled Senior Services Division Budget for the remaining 1995 fiscal

year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the recommended funding request for Elder concerns be titled Senior Services Division Budget for FY 1995.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the Senior Services Division Budget for fiscal year 1995 in the amount of \$111,381.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 07TH, day of April, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,553.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [230.0] 10 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
