RESOLUTION NO. 95-179

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is concerned about the health of its citizens and the integrity of its environment; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has taken steps to protect its citizens and its environment by applying for and receiving grant money from the United States Environmental Protection Agency under the Multi-Media and the General Assistance Indian Environmental grant programs; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive this funding, a grant application workplan and budget must be submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the submittal of a grant application, workplan, and budget to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for funding under the Indian Environmental General Assistance Grant Program.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 12TH, day of April, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,648.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 115.0 NOT VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section I(f) of Article VI of the


