3 **WHEREAS,** the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced
4 the availability of several competitive \$35,000 grants to gather input
5 regarding NAFTA from border communities; and

8 **WHEREAS,** the EPA required only a 5 page maximum pre-proposal for
9 consideration for the funding of a project; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Operations Department did submit a timely pre-
12 proposal to the EPA; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation is not obligated to any action by this
15 pre-proposal; and

17 **WHEREAS,** if the pre-proposal is accepted by the EPA, a formal application will
18 be prepared and brought at that time before both the relevant
19 committees and to the Legislative Council.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
22 Council is in support of the submission of the Border 2000 grant
23 pre-proposal to the EPA by the Planning and Operations

Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 12TH day of April, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,648.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 115.0 NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






