**RESOLUTION NO. 95-183**

**WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in 1982  
replacing CETA; and**

**WHEREAS, funding is made available to State and Tribal Governments to  
establish programs for improving the employment prospects of  
eligible persons through designation of service delivery areas; and**

**WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a network  
of employment training programs throughout the State; and**

**WHEREAS, Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated as service  
delivery areas and are eligible to receive State JTPA funds; and**

**WHEREAS, the JTPA Program submits the following documents for review and  
approval for the Title IIA Contract Proposal for Fiscal Year 1996:**

- 1) Fiscal Year 1996 Administrative Cost Pool Budget reflecting the  
planning allocation in the amount of \$19,486.00; and**
- 2) Fiscal Year 1996 Program Budget reflecting the planning  
allocation of \$103,925.00**

and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the  
duration of the contract shall be from July 1, 1995 through June 30,  
1996.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the  
Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any  
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute  
the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for  
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
on the 12TH, day of April, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present  
with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05]  
ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article  
VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy  
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
