3 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is charged with promoting
4
5 the well-being of Tohono O'odham Youth; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Indian Oasis Baboquivari Unified School District which serves
7
8 approximately 1,200 students, grades K-12 will be negatively
9
10 impacted should P.L. 81-874 monies be decreased; and

11 **WHEREAS,** Indian Lands lack a property tax base which is essential to
12
13 traditional school funding; and

14 **WHEREAS,** Indian Nations are experiencing a major decline in funding for
15
16 educational and social services; and

17 **WHEREAS,** Education in reservation settings is much more costly due to
18
19 isolation, transportation needs, and the need to have competitive
20
21 salaries to attract qualified instructors; and

22 **WHEREAS,** Impact Aid (P.L. 81-874 monies) contribute a major portion of
23
24 funding for reservation schools; and

25 **WHEREAS,** funding by both federal and state agencies for schools whether
26
27 public, tribal or Bureau of Indian Affairs, is being reduced leaving
28
tribal nations without alternative funds to replace P.L. 81-874 monies.

7 Federally Impacted school districts.



16 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




