RESOLUTION NO. 95-194

**WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in 1982
replacing Comprehensive Employment Training Act (CETA); and**

**WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) funds are made available
to State and Tribal Governments from the United States Department
of Labor to establish employment and training programs for
improving the employment prospects of eligible persons; and**

**WHEREAS, Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated as service
delivery area and are eligible to receive Federal JTPA funds; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a network of
employment training programs throughout the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Title IIB program
since 1974; and**

**WHEREAS, the JTPA Program has submitted for review and approval the Title
IIB Grant Proposal for Fiscal Year 1995, which includes:**

- FY 1995 Summer Plan Narrative**
- FY 1995 Administrative Cost Pool Budget in the
amount of \$23,491.00;**

**that it hereby approves the DOL JTPA Title IIB/ACP and Program
Budgets in the amount of \$156,608.00 for the delivery of JTPA
services.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

**Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
the grant provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for
further prior approval by this Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
the 1ST, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 07 ABSENT,
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


