**RESOLUTION NO. 95-198**

**WHEREAS, there are no other attorneys to handle conflicts which the Nation's Advocate Program is not ethically allowed to handle in the increasing needs of tribal members for legal representation in civil and criminal matters; and**

**WHEREAS, the Advocate Program wishes to retain a list of attorneys to be appointed to represent clients with conflicts of interest who can not be represented by the Nation's Advocate Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the Advocate Program wishes to retain the conflicts attorney list for the remaining five (5) months of FY-95 Fiscal Year and projects the cost of such services at \$80,000.00; and**

**WHEREAS, the Advocate Program has presented a contract for the Conflict Attorneys which confirm and ratify the terms and conditions related to future services, a copy of which is attached.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 1. The Legislative Council ratifies and approves the Conflict Attorneys Contract, in the form attached hereto, for the Conflict**




