

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Reaffirming Resolution No. 198-88 for the transfer of Government Building)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95-200

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs did offer the transfer and use of a government building to the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Judiciary did by letter express interest in use of the building identified as the Santa Rosa Boarding School old dormitory and advised the Bureau of Indian Affairs of such; and

WHEREAS, as required for the transfer, the Legislative Council did enact Resolution No. 198-88 supporting the transfer of the government building to the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the intent of Resolution No. 198-88 to transfer the building to the Nation was never fulfilled and it is necessary to reaffirm Resolution No. 198-88 to formalize the transfer of said building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby reaffirm Council Resolution No. 198-88 for the transfer of the Santa Rosa Boarding School old dormitory to the Nation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman and other



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appropriate officers of the Nation to fully execute the transfer to effectuate the intent of Resolution No. 198-88.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 2ND, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,576.0 FOR; 89.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 98.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(i) & (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






