

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Water Resources Study Program Fiscal Year 1995 Contract Initiation**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-204**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been operating the Water Resources Study Program during Fiscal Year 1994 under an extension of FY 1992 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs of issue of a new 638 contract containing FY 1995 funding, Suballotment Document OTR ID No. 210-5-33000-H02 dated December 19, 1994 providing FY 1995 340 funds. These FY 1995 entries provide \$750,000 to the Papago Agency for the Water Resources Study Program (Water Inventory Investigations) associated with P.L. 97-293, the Southern Arizona Water Settlement Act to the amount of \$500,000 and for the United States Geological Service Border Water Study to the amount of \$250,000. Additionally, there are funds amounting to \$490,700 which are carryover from Fiscal Year 1994; and**

**WHEREAS, authorization was requested and granted to enter into a joint**

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4 funding agreement between the U. S. Geological Survey and the  
5 Water Resources Department of the Tohono O'odham Nation to  
6 conduct a hydrological investigation along a portion of the southern  
7 boundary of the Nation and \$250,000 is included in the \$750,000 to  
8 fund this cooperative agreement; and

11 **WHEREAS,** all contracts and the funding levels of said contracts and  
12 amendments to previously authorized budget expenditures shall be  
13 submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham  
14 Legislative Council.  
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18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
19 Council does hereby approve the aforementioned 638 contract with  
20 the Bureau of Indian Affairs with attached FY 1995 budget of  
21 \$750,000 and an additional \$490,700 carried forward from an  
22 unexpended portion of the authorized FY 1994 budget and  
23 authorizes expenditures totaling \$1,240,700 in accordance with the  
24 attached budget.

amendment affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract  
shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

the 3RD, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT,  
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16  
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


