3 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is empowered by Article VIII, Section 4 of
4 the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation to appoint judges
5 of the Tohono O'odham Courts; and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council did by Ordinance No. 01-89, Chapter II,
9 authorize the appointment of judges pro tempore to the Tohono
10 O'odham Courts upon the recommendation of the Chief Judge; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Chief Judge has submitted the names of attorneys qualified
14 pursuant to 2-103 of Ordinance No. 01-89 and recommended their
15 appointment as judges pro tempore of the Tohono O'odham Courts;

19 **WHEREAS,** Resolution No. 93-034 and 93-139 appointed judges pro tempore for
20 terms of two years; and

22 **WHEREAS,** all the judges pro tempore terms have expired effective May 1,
23 1994 and May 1, 1995; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Chief Judge has submitted the names of six attorneys qualified
26 to fill the current expired terms of judge pro tempore; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee has met with the Chief Judge and discussed the qualifications of the individuals who are being recommended for appointment as judges pro tempore; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee has determined that the persons recommended are of good moral character, residents of the State of Arizona for not less than five years, and are admitted to the practice of law for not less than three years; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee does concur with the recommendations of the Chief Judge and recommends to the full Legislative Council six appointments of judges pro tempore for the Judicial Branch of this Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does accept the recommendation of the Chief Judge and in accordance with Judicial Branch Rules and Procedures formally adopted by this Legislative Council by Ordinance 01-89, hereby appoints the following named persons as judges pro tempore of the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch:
