**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the Tohono  
O'odham Psychological Services Day Treatment Program for the  
Seriously Mentally Ill through a P.L. 93-638 grant; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
grant shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono  
O'odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, FY 94 Carry-over funds in the amount of \$149,305.00 is reflected;  
and**

**WHEREAS, Day Treatment Programs for the seriously and persistently mentally  
ill have been effective means of providing psychosocial rehabilitation  
services; and**

**WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services TOPS/SMI Program has  
prepared and submitted a budge modification for review and  
approval.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council does hereby approve and authorize expenditures in**

designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute  
the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for  
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
the 4TH, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 04 ABSENT,  
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16  
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
