4 **WHEREAS,** at a meeting of the Pisinemo District Council held on April 19,

6 1995, the representatives of San Simon and Santa Cruz expressed

8 concern that their communities are in need of additional security

10 officers to assist the security officer who is currently employed in
11 their communities; and

12 **WHEREAS,** meetings have been held in each of the communities requesting

14 additional security and representatives from each community stated

16 that the community members from each of the two communities

18 have agreed that adding an additional security officer to their

20 community would be beneficial for the health and safety of the

22 community members; and

23 **WHEREAS,** due to the amount of illegal aliens and drug traffic that is currently

25 two of the main problems facing these communities, the Pisinemo

27 District Council approved the request of San Simon and Santa Cruz

communities to add an additional security officer in their
community at the rate of \$4.35 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the hiring of two additional security officers for the District of Pisinemo, communities of San Simon and Santa Cruz, will be \$9,234.00 of which will deducted from the Pisinemo District's Account; and

WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District's account does have monies available to cover expenditures for the hiring of the two additional security officers and the proposed starting dates for these two security officers will be May 7, 1995 and end on September 30, 1995.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation hereby approves the request of the Pisinemo District to hire two (2) additional security officers for the communities of Santa Cruz and San Simon with a proposed starting date of May 7, 1995 and ending September 30, 1995.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH day of MAY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,639.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 124.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the




